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1.Stanford Backhaul



The Stanford to Gansbaai Backhaul has been in planning since 2020, the primary goal of this project was to improve diverse routes on our backhauls out of Gansbaai. This was one of the factors that affected our service greatly the last couple of months.

The backhaul will also enable us to provide fibre to the residents on the R43. This project has several big challenges as we have to navigate with the contractors who are responsible for the upgrades to the road.

The backhaul will ensure that Stanford clients are directly connected to our distribution centre. Once completed we will notify the public of the success and what can be expected of the backhaul.

At the beginning of 2023, The Computer Hut took up the challenge to build a direct fibre line from Gansbaai to Pearly Beach.The goal of this project was to ensure that we have more than enough bandwidth for the Pearly Beach area and to ensure that services will not be affected by weather or other factors that affect wireless backhauls.

It was quite a difficult task to complete, but we made great strides to procure the correct materials and we put in immense efforts to plan correctly for the task at hand.

We built an aerial route on poles from after the Uilkraalsmond bridge up to the Pearly Beach turn-off. This project took four months to complete and we officially activated the backhaul at the end of April 2023. We are very proud of this accomplishment as this shows how far we are willing to go to ensure client satisfaction.

3.Equipment Upgrades



With the enormous growth of clients on The Computer Hut's network, we had to do some major equipment upgrades to keep up with the demand for more bandwidth. This equipment included :

- Upgrading core equipment at our Gansbaai fibre node
- Upgrading core equipment at our Pearly Beach fibre node
- Upgrading core equipment at Teraco in Rondebosch

The equipment installed at Teraco in Rondebosch serves as a distribution point for all major ISPs in the Western Cape.

We currently have dedicated Netflix and Google caching servers at our cabinet in Teraco to make it possible for our clients to have the best internet and streaming experience in their home and business. Even though we have moved the majority of our clients to our fibre network, we are continuously upgrading our wireless high sites to ensure that we can meet the high demand of bandwidth-hungry customers and provide the best wireless experience possible. These upgrades include upgrading to lithium batteries, higher bandwidth backhaul links, improved sectors, and an increase in solar charging capacity.

We have also upgraded our network's monitoring system. This improves the way we constantly monitor our network to ensure that our equipment is always operating at optimal levels and to avoid any congestion.

Some of the challenges we have faced were caused by the Level-9 storm that disrupted communities in the Western Cape. Our hearts go out to all the Stanford residents who lost a great deal with the floods. As well as everyone who incurred damages during the storm. The Computer Hut also had a lot of damage. Damage was especially bad on mountain high-sites. We lost several solar panels and various equipment damages. As soon as we could access the sites, we made repairs as well as upgrades to the current equipment.

With the current status of South Africa's power grid, The Computer Hut was forced to adapt to the situation. Computer Hut had a solar system in place for backup power, but due to equipment upgrades and more clientele, we needed to do some upgrades to the current system.

So what did The Computer Hut do? We upgraded our solar capacity as well as our inverter system from 8KVA to 16KVA. We also bought an industrial 20KVA generator to support the solar and keep the backup power running. All of this is to ensure that we keep the connectivity on when there are interruptions from Eskom.

Due to the fact that The Computer Hut can not power your home or supply power to your home, we have various models of backup power models to keep your internet equipment powered on during load shedding. You can visit our office and speak to agents about the best solution for your internet.


4.Back-up Power

5.Back-up Connectivity



Openserve classifies Gansbaai as a rural area and has the only fibre backhaul out of Gansbaai. Outages on this backhaul have had severe consequences on our service delivery. This manifests in multiple forms such as routine maintenance on our feeder cables from Cape Town, storm damage, damage as a result of malicious intent and general maintenance of exchanges. We would like to take this opportunity to thank Openserve for their timely repairs and assistance during this past year. Therefore we were forced to think outside of the box and collaborate with other service providers to have back-up internet links so that our clients can still have a connection, although the speed is not always optimal to continue normally.

We now have the following backup links in place:

- Gansbaai
- Stanford
- Hermanus
- Bredasdorp
- Satellite
- Starlink

We walk the extra mile for each and everyone, and because we value you as a client so much, we put measures in place that support our view

One of the biggest projects is a hybrid fibre line deployed from Grootbos to Baardskeerdersbos.

Phase 1 of the project will start at the Grootbos turn-off on the R43 and continue to De Uijlenes' turn-off on the Baardskeerdersbos road.

Phase 2 will consist of completing the project up to and including Baardskeerdersbos. We are also going to do major upgrades to our networking hardware to enhance the overall customer experience as well as to ensure that we can supply better support to our clients.

With regards to streaming, The Computer Hut receives a lot of support calls coming through about clients who are struggling with buffering streams. During these calls, we found that a lot of our clients are streaming from locations that are not secure. During the Rugby World Cup a lot of secure service providers had issues and there were online articles released on the difficulties they faced. Streaming has made huge strides in providing content to consumers. However streaming has its own difficulties if you make use of unsecure streams.

If you make use of unsecure streams, please note that we are not liable for buffering or slow connections from the stream provider. These sites have very little server capacity and cause slow and buffering connections. Some streaming sites are paid streaming sites, this does not make them secure. Current legitimate streaming services in South Africa include ShowMax, Netflix, DStv Stream, HBO Max, Amazon Prime, Hulu, Britbox, Disney+, AppleTV, SABC+ and YouTube.

If you encounter any issues with unsecure streaming, please know that we can not assist. The best way to test if you have an issue is to open YouTube and check if the same difficulties are present there as well. If not, then you know it is the stream and not your internet.

Untrusted Sources:

• Unreliable / Low Quality

Unsecure streams often come from unverified or questionable sources, in the context of online streaming, unsecure streams typically refers to a video or audio stream that is delivered over the internet without proper security measures in place, which can lead to unreliable or low-quality content. This can manifest in several ways. Unsecure sites may experience frequent downtime, slow streaming speeds, or server issues, making it frustrating to watch content consistently. Such sources may also include pirated or illegally distributed material. You may encounter buffering, pixelation, and other issues that can diminish your viewing experience. Shows and movies may be taken down or moved frequently, causing frustration for users. While some unsecure streaming sites may offer a wide range of content, others may have a limited selection, particularly for newer or less popular titles.







• Malware / Viruses / Security Threats

Unsecure streams may not use encryption to protect the data being transmitted. Without encryption, the content can potentially be intercepted and viewed by unauthorised parties, posing a privacy risk. Unsecure streams may lack authentication mechanisms, which means anyone can access the content without proving their identity. This can lead to unauthorised access and content piracy. Many unsecure streaming sites offer copyrighted content without proper licensing or permission. Accessing and streaming such content can lead to legal repercussions, including fines and lawsuits. Unsecure streaming sites often host malicious ads, pop-ups, and downloads. Clicking on these can expose your device to malware, viruses, and other malicious software that can harm your computer or steal your personal information.

No Support

Unsecure streams may lack customer support, and if you encounter issues or problems with the content, you may have no recourse or way to address these problems. The problem is not your internet service provider.

• Data Privacy Risk

Unsecure streaming sites may collect and sell your personal data without your consent, exposing you to privacy risks. Your personal information may be used for targeted advertising or other nefarious purposes. Unsecure streams may lack authentication mechanisms, which means anyone can access the content without proving their identity. This can lead to unauthorised access and content piracy.

• Legal Consequences

Many unsecure streaming sites offer copyrighted content without proper licensing or permission. Accessing and streaming such content can lead to legal repercussions, including fines and lawsuits. Unsecure streaming sites may inadvertently support illegal activities, which could result in legal consequences for users.

The Computer Hut's Recommendation:

- 1. Connect your streaming device via cable to the primary router in your home. This will rule out interference and Wi-Fi signals.
- 2. Play a test video from YouTube.
- 3. If the connection is unstable, make use of different devices (Laptop, Cell Phone or Desktop PC)
- 4. Many smart TV's have various issues. They become outdated and applications (Apps) can not update to the latest version. This has a direct influence on your streaming experience. The Computer Hut has a test Media Player for our clients to use to fault find streaming issues. If possible, buy a normal TV and and not a smart TV, rather buy a Google Certified media player and connect it directly to your primary router.




